I am requesting funding for Monroe County CTH ET Multimodal and Freight Corridor in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Monroe County Highway Department, located at 803 Washington Street, Sparta, WI 54656.

The funding would be used to address safety concerns, enhance the movement of freight, provide safe access to agriculture, industrial, commercial, recreational and residential interests, enhance access to the Tomah VA Medical Center and the U.S. Army's Fort McCoy, and provide multimodal opportunities, including freight and passenger rail, and vehicular, bicycle and pedestrian.
